<u>Spelling Rule:</u> Words that end in ious. Within this spelling list there are two main sounds at the end of the words – ‘tious’ (shus) and ‘ious’ (eeus).	<u>Spelling Rule:</u> Root words that end in ‘ce’ usually use ‘cious’ when adding the ‘ious’ suffix, however it is often not possible to identify a root word.	<u>Spelling Rule:</u> Words ending in cial often have a vowel right before the suffix is added. But there are exceptions to the rule.	Scientific vocabulary to support Science quest writing	<u>Spelling Rule:</u> Words ending in ‘tial’ often have a consonant right before the suffix is added. But there are exceptions to the rule.	<u>Spelling Rule:</u> The last two spelling lists looked at ‘cial’ ending after a vowel and ‘tial’ endings after a consonant. There are exceptions to this rule and they just need to be remembered. This week is a list of exceptions to the rule.	<u>Spelling Rule:</u> Challenge words.
