The School Day

The school day kicks off at 8:40 am and wraps up at 3:10 pm for the little ones (Reception, Year 1, 2), or 3:20 pm for older children (Years 3-6). Everyone gets to refuel with morning breaks, and the younger ones have an additional break in the afternoon.

Wraparound

We have wraparound care available for our families through S4YC, an OFSTED outstanding provider. Breakfast club begins at 7.45am and after school club runs until 6.00pm.

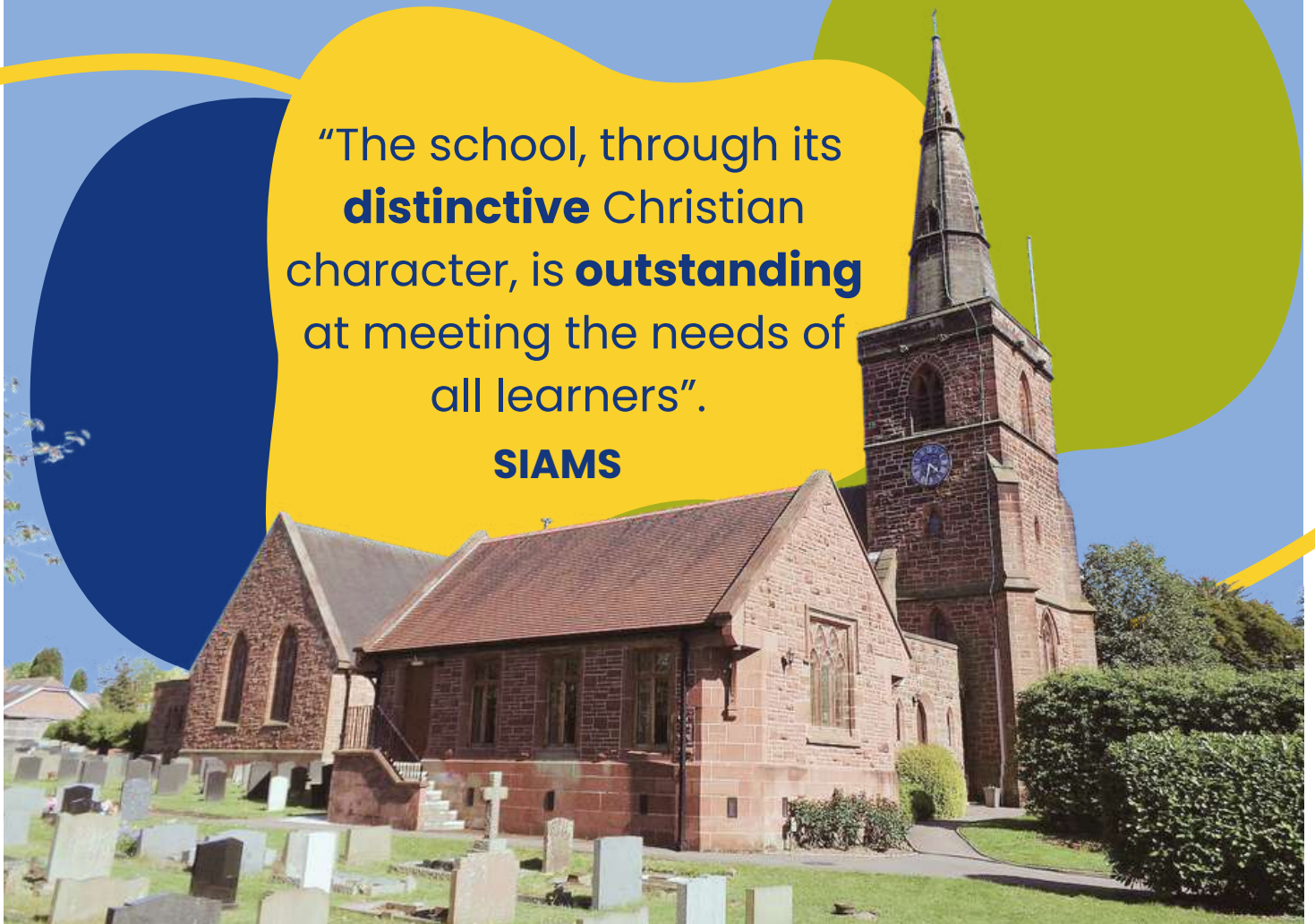
Worship
